
Well done to the winners of our 'Turn the lights off' poster competition – I think you can agree their posters look fantastic, we hope that they encourage everyone to save energy!

#### **Payments**



Please could I remind you to ensure that you are up to date on payments on ParentPay, (for Breakfast / Angels club fees) and Arbor (for school meals). It is important that these accounts remain in credit and do not go into arrears. If payments are made for Breakfast / Angels through Child Care Vouchers, please allow time for these to be credited to our bank account. If you have any queries, please contact the school office.

#### **Collecting Children**

Please could we remind parents that when parking to drop off or collect children, please could you turn off your car engines. Research into the environmental impact of cars that are parked, but keep their engines running, has shown high levels of pollution, particularly in cold weather. Please let's make it a healthier environment for our children. As always, please remember to park with consideration to our neighbours, not parking over their driveways.

When dropping off or collecting children, for those parents whose children are in classes on the far side of school ie Yrs 3, 4 and 5, **please remember to use the one-way system around school,** to alleviate congestion in the narrow walkway outside these classrooms. Parents of children in Nursery, Reception, Years 1, 2 and 6 have the option of exiting via the main entrance where there is considerably wider access. If you are late arriving to drop off or pick up a child, please come to the main school office.

#### Parkina

A polite reminder not to park illegally on Barkers Lane – local residents have contacted the school noting that there are cars who are parking opposite the junction to St Mary's (exit end) which causes congestion for cars turning out of St Mary's and is a danger to children trying to cross over at that point.

Are you driving to school? - If so, please use the one way system around St Mary's Road to avoid congestion.

DO NOT park on the Zig Zag lines - they are there to protect the children.

DO NOT park across residents driveways.
